Notice of Race for National 12 GUL Finale (5th November) and Inland Championship (5th and 6th November) and the OK Open Meeting on Saturday 5th and Sunday 6th November 2016 at Pitsford Reservoir

The event will be classified Category “C” in accordance with RRS appendix 1.

The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, and the event sailing instructions

Competitors should note that Northampton Sailing Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.

Conditions of Entry

The safety of a boat and her entire management including insurance shall be the sole responsibility of the owner/competitor racing the boat, who must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the sailing instructions, nor the inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/competitor for his/her crew his/her boat and the management thereof. The race organizers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury however caused to the owner/competitor, his skipper or crew as a result of their taking part in the race or races. Moreover, every owner/competitor warrants the suitability of his boat for the race or races.

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid Third Party Liability Insurance with a minimum cover of £3 million.
