

WELCOME:

The Solway Yacht Club is keen to welcome the National 12 GUL series once more to Kippford. While we don't have an N12 fleet, there is a long established Open meeting here for N12s and we have several members with a keen interest in the Class and many enthusiastic cadets eager to crew these exciting boats. We warmly invite you to join us for our event on Saturday 23rd and Sunday 24th September.

The Urr and the Solway offer wonderful sailing in a great environment and in a setting of outstanding natural beauty. The clubhouse is in an elevated position with views over to Glen Isle. The Club site offers excellent launching, pontoons and guest moorings.

ACCOMMODATION and PARKING

There are many hotels and boarding houses within easy walking or motoring distance as well as caravan, camping and holiday chalets nearby, but early reservations are advised at popular times.

There is limited car parking space at the club site and public car park. Other than to drop off or collect boats, vehicles are not permitted onto the pier area and boat park for competitors' safety.

CATERING, BAR and SOCIAL EVENT

Hot food will be available after racing. The Club is fully licensed and competitors and visiting members will be Temporary Members for the duration of their stay. A social ewvent is planned for the evening of Saturday 23rd.

HOW TO FIND US

Kippford lies to the south of Dalbeattie along the A710. From the west, follow the A745 and then the

A711 from Castle Douglas to the boundary of Dalbeattie. From the north, follow the A711 from Dumfries until the far end of Dalbeattie. For both, now take the A710, which is signposted "Solway Coast". Follow this road for around 3 miles and then turn right at a sign for Kippford (also mentions sailing and golf). The clubhouse is just before the foot of the hill on the left and the boat park is on the right just round a sharp left corner.

- 1. The organizing authority is The Solway Yacht Club
- 2. Eligible Classes:

All National 12s meeting the class association rules are eligible to enter. The results will be calculated based on overall positions with separate awards for modern foiling designs, modern double bottom designs, Admirals Cup and Vintage boats.

- 3. Rules:
 - The racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017-2020, the event Sailing Instructions and the relevant Class Association rules.
- Race Area: Racing will take place in the Urr estuary and out into the Solway Firth; see Sailing Area above.
- 5. Entries: Entry Forms are attached and must be completed with payment of entry fee before commencement of the briefing. Entry fee for the event is £30 per boat. You can enter online here. Online entries are preferred but paper entries are also welcome.
- 6. Registration & Briefing: Registration for those not already entered will take place between 10:00 and 10:30 on Saturday 23rd September with the briefing in the Clubhouse at 10:45. Printed SIs will be available.
- 7. Number of Races and Times: It is anticipated that there will be 3 Races daily with first warning signal at 12:50 on Satyrday and 13:20 on Sunday. Subsequent races will follow on. Depending on the wind, it can take a little time to get to the sailing area and a prompt start is necessary.
- 8. Prizes:

At the discretion of SYC and dependent on numbers, prizes may be awarded to the first boat in each category. In addition the series sponsor GUL Watersports may provide prize vouchers for each category.

Additional Information:

- 9. Personal buoyancy must be worn by all competitors. Boat buoyancy may be subject to scrutiny. A painter of 5 metres must be carried on all boats.
- 10. Visitors and competitors are asked to respect the local amenities and residents during their stay at Kippford.
- 11. Children under 14 are not permitted in the clubhouse after 10pm.
- 12. Dogs should be kept on a leash at all times.
- 13. Car numbers should be kept to a minimum and should be parked in club or public car parks as they are not allowed on the pier once the series has started.
- 14. Any alterations to these conditions or other details of this entry form shall be at the sole discretion of the Commodore and Race Committee of Solway Yacht Club
