Commentary

The list above shows that around 300 Vintage Twelves have been seen/reported in print, during the years 2000-2007. As suggested in the introduction, possibly a number of those seen in the early years of this survey have been abandoned and written off. On the other hand, the number of newly rediscovered boats has consistently been about 30 per year, but tapering down to 22 last year. Since 1st November I have noted 6 hitherto unrecorded boats.

Analysts have plenty of data here to play with! For example it would be interesting to present the numbers of boats surviving in each band of sail numbers, in the form of a histogram. It would also be interesting to see how well, particular designs of boat have survived.

In conclusion, the on-going total of Vintage Twelves still in existence may be perhaps 320 -350 for the next few years.
