### **BRIXHAM YACHT CLUB FACILITIES**

### **CLUBHOUSE, DINGHY PARK AND CAR PARKING**

The Clubhouse is on Overgang Road close to The Quay. Entering the Club from the road you find the bar and restaurant which overlooks the sea. Carry on downstairs, step outside and carry on down where you will find the steps up (!! sorry) to the National Twelve Race Office. Carry on further down and you will reach the Club dinghy park and alongside it is the public car park.

When arriving by car you drive along Overgang Road past the Club and reach the far end of the public car park. You can drive through this to the dinghy park and drop off your boat.

The championship dinghy park is the space usually occupied by club boats so it won't be marked with berth numbers. On Friday and Saturday there should be someone to advise you where to go. Sorry, but trailers will have to live under boats, if there are any double trailers you will need to ask what can be arranged.

This is a Pay and Display car park so please don't get caught out without a ticket. Instead of feeding a machine at £8 per day you could consider purchasing a weekly ticket in advance from Torbay council, via the internet at £33. This means no hunting for change and if you arrive on Friday would be more economic. This is apparently a scratch card and is valid for 7 days starting from whichever day of the week you wish.

This ticket can be used on any of the other Torbay council car parks (Torquay, Paignton or Brixham), but not on street parking. Useful if non sailing members of your family want to tour the area. We have been advised that these charges should not be changing.
