### 1. Rules

Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021 – 2024 (RRS) The prescriptions of the RYA, the Sailing Instructions and the Class Association Rules.

### 2. Eligibility and Entry

The N12 event is open to N12 Association members and any member of RSC, but only N12 Association members will have their results entered as part of the associated series. The single hander event is not a class specific meeting and is open to any visitor or RSC member sailing a single-handed dinghy of less than 15 feet (4.5m) and with a RYA PN of between 1213 and 1002. Classes sailed at the club include the likes of: Streaker, Solo, Supernova, OK, ILCA 7/6/4, Phantom and Aero.

### 3. Registration

All competitors, *including members of RSC*, must register via completion of the event-specific form and pay the entry fee. Registration will be open from 09:30 on Saturday 5 October 2024.

### 4. Entry Fee

The entry fee will include lunch and free tea/coffee and is £20 per single hander and £25 for National 12s.

### 5. Schedule of Races



Competitor Briefing will be at approximately 10:30, outside the race hut. The warning flag for the first race will be flown no earlier than 11:00; start times for subsequent races will be displayed on the day. There will be two starts, with the N12s first and the single handers 3 minutes later.

## **6. Number of Races**

Normally, three races will be sailed, with two results to count. If less than three races are sailed, all results will count.

## **7. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing Instructions are available to download from the club's website.

## **8. Insurance**

All boats must be covered by a minimum of £3,000,000 third party liability Insurance. Completion and signing of the entry form confirms acceptance of this requirement.
