

Notice of Race: National 12 Vintage Championship 2024.

The National 12 Vintage Championship is scheduled for July 13th -14th 2024 and will be organised by **Nottinghamshire County Sailing Club** (NCSC) at Hoveringham Nottinghamshire NG14 7GS All racing, officials and competitors shall be governed by the rules defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021–2024, except as shall be modified by the NCSC Sailing Instructions and the Rules of National Twelve Class except restricted by the following:-

- a. Boats competing are to be of a wooden clinker or ribbed wood construction.
- b. No foiled rudders or trim tab centreboards allowed.
- c. No boats with double floors will be allowed.
- d. No carbon masts permitted; carbon booms are permitted.

Registration

The entry fee is: £30.00 for the two days. Entries Online at https://members.ncsc.org.uk//event/886981. Select "National 12 Vintage championships Entry & fee payment" at the bottom of the list of "Tickets". You will be asked to register on our SCM system as a temporary member and then you can add your details before proceeding to the credit card payment stages.

Sailing instructions and NOR can be uploaded from the Registration page.

Booking-in will be located in the clubhouse, where copies of the Sailing Instructions will be available.

Briefing

A briefing will take place at the Clubhouse at 10.00am on Saturday 13th July.

Programme of Racing

There will 4 races (2 per day) over the weekend.

Saturday 2 Races - Warning signal for the first race will not be before 11.30 hrs.

Sunday 2 Races - warning signal for the first race will not be before 11.00 hrs

Number of Races to Count / Discards.

The Gill Half Model (Glued Clinker) and Gill Admirals Cup (Ribbies). 4 races, 3 to count.

D.R.S.C. J & T Hancock Trophy. 4 races, 3 to count, based on Handicaps applied to the timed race results for the Gill Half Model. The changes to the PYN to be determined by the timings of the 1st Race.
